Each person 18 years or older are required to **abstain from meat** (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

Every person between the age of 18 and 59 (beginning of 60th year) are **required to fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting consists of only one full meal with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to one single full meal.
