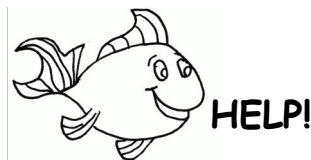

Fasting consists of only one full meal with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to one single full meal.
