Please take a Rice Bowl from the basket in the gathering space. This is a Lenten program of prayer, fasting, learning and giving to the poor.

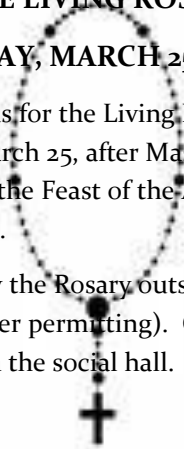
